


Mission

Mary's Inn is a maternity home dedicated to the physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being of single pregnant mothers and their developing babies. It is a safe haven where they can stay while learning the skills they need to make a better life for themselves and their babies.



I hope you will indulge me in a little story this month.

We have lived in our new maternity home for almost two years now. But from 1951-1971 Angelo & Ruth Kerper raised their five kids here. Harry, their youngest, was born with a malformed heart and would need surgery by age 3 or he wouldn't live past age 5. The parents had a great devotion to St. Anne so they decided to make a pilgrimage to the Shrine of St. Anne de Beaupre in Quebec, Canada and ask for a miracle through her intercession. Two months after they returned home, tests showed that Harry's heart was completely normal. His story is in the book, "A Land of Miracles for Three Hundred Years," which documents miracles that occurred through the intercession of St. Anne.

Then when Harry was a freshman at Wahlert, he and a friend ran to a local grocery store, where he collapsed and died from a heart attack. He was 14. His family built a grotto to St. Anne in the backyard in thanksgiving for Harry's additional years of life. Joe & Carol Bitter later bought the house and deconstructed the grotto to put on an addition in 1994. The two stones, one in memory of Harry and one in honor of St. Anne, were put into the addition's foundation.

Late last year, Janice Kerper Even approached me and inquired about the possibility of reconstructing the grotto. She and her siblings would take care of all expenses. We thought it fit with our mission of serving moms - after all, St. Anne is the mother of the Mother of God - so we gladly gave them permission. Below are some pictures of the new grotto.
